



Stripes and Triangles Go-Over

Revised

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This pattern is worked in one piece from the neck down. Change colours as you wish to create stripes.

Finished size: 59 cm/23" across the chest and 13cm/5" longer than wide. The longer length will keep the child's tummy covered.

KAS would appreciate sweaters that will fit 3-10 year old children.



Materials and Equipment

- Worsted weight yarn (American) / DK (UK) / 8ply (Aus)
- 4.50 mm/US 7 hook
- 4.00 mm/US 6 hook

Abbreviations

Note: Pattern uses American terminology

American	British
slip stitch (sl st)	single crochet (sc)
single crochet (sc)	double crochet (dc)
half double crochet (hdc)	half treble crochet (htc)
double crochet (dc)	treble (tr)

Instructions

Neckline:

Using 4.50 mm/US 7 hook

Row 1: Chain (ch) 63, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, and each ch across. Ch 2, turn. (counts as 1st hdc in next row) (61 sts).

Row 2: 1 hdc in next 9 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 9 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 21 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 9 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 10 sts to end. ch 2, turn.

Row 3: 1 hdc in next 10 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 11 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 23 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 11 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 11 sts to end. ch 2, turn.

Row 4: 1 hdc in next 11 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 13 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 25 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 13 sts, 3 hdc in next st (corner made). 1 hdc in next 12 sts to end. ch 2, turn.

Repeat row 4, continue increasing at each corner until Go-Over measures 13cm (5") from neck. (this is the front opening allowance)

At the end of the row, join to the beginning of the row with sl st, making a circle. Bind off.

Triangle pattern:

Rnd 1: Starting at underarm with colour A, ch2, hdc in each stitch remembering to increase at the corners. *You are now working in the round.*

Rnd 2: With colour A. Ch2, hdc in first 2 st, attach colour B, hdc in next st, Follow AABAABAABAAB pattern to end of row. (at corners continue in AAB pattern)Turn. Ch 2 (Note: it is important to turn at this point so the pattern makes the triangles.)

Rnd 3: With colour A hdc in first st, Change to colour B, hdc in next 2 sts. Follow ABBABBABBABB pattern to end of row. (at corners continue in ABB pattern). Cut off colour A, leaving length to tuck in.

Rnd 4: Using colour B, Ch 2, hdc in each stitch remembering to increase at each corner.

The triangle pattern is now complete.

Continue increasing at corners until G-O measures 18 cm/7" from shoulder to underarm.

Armhole:

Ch 2, hdc in stitches across the front to middle stitch of 3 hdc group, ch 2, skip sts in between until the next corner[armhole opening]. Hdc in middle st of 3 hdc group and across the back to next corner, ch 2, skip sts in between to the next corner[armhole opening]. Hdc across to end. Sl st in top of ch 2.

Body:

Continue working in the round.

Rnd 1: Ch 1. Sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first st.

Repeat rnd 1 until desire length. Add stripe pattern as desired. Finished length should be approximately 13 cm/5" longer than wide.

Sleeve:

Rnd 1: With right side facing. Join with sl stitch in middle stitch at bottom of armhole. Ch1, sc in same stitch as join, sc in all stitches around. Join with sl st.

Rnd 2: ch 1, sc in same st as ch. Sc in next stitches around.

Repeat rnd 2 until sleeve measures 36 cm/14" from underarm.

Cuff:

Change to 4.00 mm/US 6 hook.

Rnd 1: Join at any stitch in underarm, sc2tog around, repeat around opening. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 2: .Ch 1, sc in each st around. Join with sl st to first sc. Repeat until cuff measures 3-5 cm/1-2" wide.

Repeat for other sleeve.

Finishing:

Sc around neckline and front opening. If adding a button, make a loop (using chain st) on the opposite side of the opening to accommodate the button. Sew button securely to Go-Over using button thread or yarn, and tuck in all ends.

Variations

Variation 1:

You can add another row of triangles facing in the opposite direction at the bottom of the Go-Over, by using the "triangle pattern" section of the instructions, inverting your colours.

Variation 2: Omitting the triangles.

Follow the pattern until you come to the triangle pattern. Then follow these directions:



Rnd 1: Starting at underarm with colour A, ch2, hdc in each stitch remembering to increase at the corners. *You are now working in the round.*
Continue with hdc, increasing at corners until G-O measures 18 cm/7" from shoulder to underarm.

Return to the original pattern. Work the armholes and the remainder of the pattern.

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
