



Alternating Broken Rib

A lovely warm, textured square, it is basically just 3 pattern rows, but they need to be knitted in blocks of 6 to form the pattern (12 rows total).



Materials and Equipment

- Worsted (American) / Double Knitting (UK) / 8 ply (Aust)
- One pair 4 mm/6 US needles

Note: Depending upon the yarn you may need to start with a different number of stitches but always use an odd number (i.e. 37, 39)

Instructions:

Cast on 41 stitches.

Row 1: Knit 1, Purl 1

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Knit 1, Purl 1

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Knit 1, Purl 1

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: Purl 1, Knit 1

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: Purl 1, Knit 1

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: Purl 1, Knit 1

Row 12: Knit

Repeat these 12 rows until the square is 8 inches/20 cm
