



Two Stitch Rib Square

Here is another delightful pattern to knit.

This square, as well as being warm, will provide the children with a tactile pattern to explore.



Materials and Equipment

- Light worsted yarn / DK (UK) / 8 ply (Aust)
- One pair needles to suit your yarn

Instructions

Cast on a multiple of 2 stitches plus 1 i.e: 34 + 1

If using 2 strands of yarn you will not need quite as many stitches

Row 1: Knit to end of row

Row 2: P1 *k1, p1* repeat *to end of row

Next row: Repeat rows 1 and 2 until work measures 20cm / 8 inches

Cast off/bind off. Leave a 50 cm/20" tail (for sewing the squares together). Butterfly* the tail to the square.

**How to 'butterfly the tail' is as easy as 1, 2, 3 . Use contrasting yarn and follow the directions:*



Variations

Use colourful yarn to add a bright square to a child's blanket.
